# **OUR STORY**

In late 2015, an ensemble of local professional African American actors and the founders of Open Stage of Harrisburg began to seriously dialogue about the need for an African American led and focused theatrical arena beyond the obligatory February production commemorating Black History Month. Conceptual discussion moved to establishing a formalized founding committee to complete missioning, visioning, and program development work. Following an extensive strategic planning process Sankofa African Theatre Company (SAATC) was incorporated in 2017 and received status as a 501(c) (3) not-for-profit theatre organization.

SAATC became autonomous in 2018, received support from The Foundation for Enhancing Communities Arts for All Program and was placed on a funding track with the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts.







# **OUR STORY** CONTINUED

Since its inception SAATC has:

- Consistently increased representation of African American theatre artists and audience members to be more reflective of the demographic diversity of the Harrisburg area.
- Strengthened the cultural and education landscape of the region through twelve artistically strong theatre productions that have reached 10,000 adults and students.
- Continued positive economic impact in the local community. Attracted and competitively engaged BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, and People of Color) actors and staff, who do not have ready access to the existing theatre community.
- Formed strong collaborative partnerships with other arts organizations in Dauphin and Cumberland Counties such as Gamut Theatre, Open Stage, WITF, The Monument Project, Theatre Harrisburg, West Shore Theatre and West Shore Symphony Orchestra carrying out its mission to illuminate African American history and culture and cultivate healthy spaces for cross-cultural dialogue and learning.


